David Seddon, a school Governor delivered a Year 6 workshop based on Shakespeare.


Nursery Rhyme Week – Nursery focussed their learning on rhymes and learnt lots of traditional rhymes that could be hard around school!

Inclusion Support

We continue to receive a School Age Plus worker for a day a week in school. Sarah B is in school every Wednesday morning for any families that would like to drop in and seek advice about any support needed in the home.

We have a Mental Health Worker in school each week, funded by the Government to work with identified children. We hope that this support continues into next academic year.

Family Hub, based in the Surestart building, is a service that offers advice to families including health, financial or social. Please drop into the Surestart and speak to professionals or come into school and we can support you with your visit.

We offer an open door policy at our school and have 3 members of staff available. Our Inclusion team consists of Richard Clarke (Pastoral and Care Manager), Sarah Gee (SEND and Assistant Headteacher) and Tracey Hester (Behaviour Mentor). Please always feel you can come into

school to ask if you need any help. If we are unable to help we can signpost you to other agencies that may offer support.

We have signed up to the Food Bank delivery each week as we feel we can offer this from school. If you need any support with food vouchers please do not hesitate to let a member of the inclusion team know or send an email to the Head teacher account. We are here to help.
